Future of the Knowledge Quarter

Zuidas is not only a unique, international part of Amsterdam, but it is also turning into a lively urban district thanks to the concentration of companies and agencies located there, along with a growing population of local residents. The Knowledge Quarter (see the red square on the map above) is not only home to Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam and Amsterdam UMC, but also to SC Buitenveldert, ACTA and various other companies and institutions that focus on knowledge and innovation. In the coming years, the range of facilities, housing stock and the office supply will continue to grow, making the Knowledge Quarter an even more appealing place to live, work and study.

Zuidasdok construction

Preparations for Zuidasdok construction will begin soon. A work site will be set up at the end of July between Arnold Schönberglaan, Gustav Mahlerplein and Parnassusweg. This site will be used for the renovation of Amsterdam Zuid Station, and for the construction of the car tunnel at a later stage. Metro 51 will continue to operate as usual until March 2019. The bicycle racks along Arnold Schönberglaan will be removed to create space for the construction site and to ensure that pedestrians and local deliveries are unimpeded. We will erect perimeter fencing and level the terrain. Materials will then be carted in and we will start work on the new rail platforms in early 2019. These rail platforms will form the roof of the Britten Passage, the station's new entrance and exit.

Please join us on 9 July for the information meeting on Zuidasdok and the Knowledge Quarter. Naturally, you can ask questions and speak with project employees. We will also provide you with information on this summer's road work on De Boelelaan.
